

# Code of Conduct



1. Be respectful towards each other (behavior, incidental speech, dialogues, game playing, etc.)
2. Clean up after yourself (stones, bowls, kitchen, trash, dishes, library books, bathroom, etc.)
  - a. Go bowls are to be placed on top of the Go board.
  - b. Chairs are to be tucked in under the table.
